Windows Update is a free Microsoft service for the Windows operating system that is automated to download and install software updates over the Internet. This service provides software updates for Windows, service packs, hotfixes, and Microsoft antivirus products (such as Windows Defender) and driver updates for hardware devices. Windows updates are a required part of all Windows operating systems. Operating system updates are automatically installed on most computers running Windows. However, unlike earlier versions of Windows, there is no way to select a specific update to download. All updates are automatically installed, including security updates, Windows Defender-defined updates, optional updates, and driver updates. In fact, you can choose when to install these updates.
